In conjunction with Foster Jones & Associates, Inc., Mendrop~Wages, LLC has been involved in the coordination of all aspects of conceptual planning, preliminary design, and final design of the new Koch Foods Feed Manufacturing Facility in Morton, Mississippi. The new facility will include a loop track, rail yard, access road to the site, and onsite drives and parking areas.

More specifically, the loop track is a looped rail spur with capacity to handle a 125-65' rail car train with three locomotives. The rail yard will have the capacity to store 80 rail cars and connects to the loop track. The design features a soft stock unloading track and tail track. Both were designed to conform to the design criteria established by the Kansas City Southern Railway Company. The access road of approximately 5,000 feet in length is designed to extend from the existing Herring Road to the new mill site. The road consists of a two lane, two way asphalt roadway with concrete curb and gutter. As for mill site grading, it will initially consist of grading necessary for preparation of mill site construction truck and employee parking.
